Warilla Barrack Point Surf Lifesaving Club has just completed our 50th season of patrols at Warilla Beach.

After 18 months planning our anniversary weekend 2-4th October was a great success and well supported by past and present members. Friday night was an informal night with a meet and greet of over 200 members and guest attending. Lots of stories went out with the tide that night.

Saturday was a formal night held at the Windang Bowls Club. Again, we had over 250 in attendance. Special guest, Ron Rankin, National President SLSA, spoke in glowing terms of the success of our club in both lifesaving and competition over the past 50 years.

Another special guest was David Smith, our first club member to become an Olympian. David presented our club with his team jacket worn at the Opening Ceremony of the 2008 Olympics. In return the Club President, Alan Beveridge, presented David with an Anniversary Cap.

On the Sunday, the theme was back to the beach, where Warilla Bowls Club who have been an outstanding club supporter, presented the club with a new Rhino 4 wheel Drive Rescue Vehicle.

What a great weekend of celebrations and special thanks to our organizing committee.

The 2009/10 season has been another successful one for our club, with members spending over 5000 voluntary hours patrolling Warilla Beach. It is our aim always to provide a safe beach for the general public and in this area our patrolling members have excelled in their vigilance and service. We can report no fatalities at Warilla Beach.

Our thanks to club captain Peter Condran and Wynn Morris our Rescue Services Co-coordinator and all Patrol Captains who managed to obtain a high standard of participation from their respective patrols. Over 68% of our members have received 100% patrol attendance. It is also pleasing to see our membership numbers have increased in both senior and junior activities.

This season our surf patrols on the Saturday, Sunday and public holiday were from 9.00am to 5.00pm. An obligation successfully met by our club members.

At the same time a patrol audit was conducted by Surf Life Saving NSW. It highlighted the fact that the procedures that were put in place by the committee were followed and that the audit was quickly completed without problems.

Of significant contribution towards our achievements was the award training led by Dave Hough and Nathan Perretta with assistance from the ever green Jim Field, Michael Beveridge & Hayley Mansbridge. This team ably led 41 candidates through the successful completion of their surf lifesaving awards. As we know the training officers are vital to the success of a club, so again we say thanks to Dave and Nathan.

Our building committee is redrafting plans for the surf club renovations. These will be submitted to Shellharbour City Council, as soon as they are ready.

On the 7th May our club held a successful golf day at Calderwood Golf Course. This was a great fund raiser for our club and thanks to Shane, Stewart and the band of helpers and golfers. Also over the season we held BBQ's at Bunning's and if not for the efforts of Bruce and Bev Tener these days would not have been successful.

David Smith was once again selected in the National Kayak Team to compete in three World cup events in Europe, winning gold. Also competing at the World Championships finishing second in the K2 was Maddison Prior who was also selected in the Australian Junior Kayaking Team to contest the Junior World Championship finishing a creditable 8th in the K1.

At the Shellharbour City Sports Awards David Smith was the Open Sports Star Of The Year. Junior Sports Star was Maddison Prior and team of the year was our U/19s males, consisting of Ali Day, Hayden White and Ben Prior. Scott Smith has been selected in the Australian Youth Olympic to compete in Singapore in September 2010. We wish Scottie all the best.

Our club played host to rounds of the Sydney Water Surf Series and the South Coast Boat Series. It was great to see so many of our club members assisting on these days. The club is appreciative of all members who assist the club in any way a member can.

In competition our club had another outstanding season. This can be attributed to our coaches and those who assisted and to the members whose dedication to training allows them to reach the high level of competition at Branch, State and Australian Championships.

Donna Bagnall, with the assistance of Lorraine Bradwell has volunteered to take on the position, thanks Donna and Lorraine and special thanks to Rachel.

Lorraine Bradwell took on the position of Secretary and in her first season has quickly learn't the ropes (highs & lows??) of the position. Presentation Night, this was one of the best attended we have had for a number of years, a good meal was provided, awards presented and a DJ provided music. A good night was had by all who attended.

Competition wise we again excelled. We have won the Sydney Water Series 8 times. This is a credit to our junior and senior members (and trainers/coaches) when you think about it, when the series started a number of our senior members were in the junior ranks. It has been great to see them develop.

The club's Golf Day was a real success. The organisers did a great job, everyone who went had a good day, looks like being a yearly fixture.

Bits & Pieces:

Patrols.

Indications are we will be required to do full patrols from October to April each year, this is still to be ratified by Branch. A recent communication from State Centre is proposing a 3 year Service Level Agreement for clubs, this will allow for a phase in period for clubs to eventually perform full patrols for the season. It will be interesting to see how other clubs deal with this.

OHS requirements.

Clubs are on notice that Workcover/State Centre are pushing clubs to have their OHS processes in place. Terry Waine has spent considerable time developing this and will be looking at the committee implementing the OHS requirements from next season.

Members Code of Conduct.

Unfortunately some members (very very few) fail to follow the Code. When this happens it can create situations that can impact on a number of people and can result in resentment and ill feeling. If a member feels they have not been spoken to or treated in a fair manner then they are encouraged to contact one of our member protection officers or approach one of the Executive.

In finishing I would like to thank President Alan for his efforts, a lot of work he does is behind the scenes which not many members are aware of. I know he has put a lot of time & effort into progressing the extensions to our building as well as other issues affecting the club.

The season has been a very progressive one for the club.

Our new training officer Nathan Perretta has done an outstanding job this season within the club and also within the South Coast Branch. Nathan with the assistance and experience of Jim Field, Michael Beveridge, Hayley Mansbridge and Jim Poplin have trained an additional 21 Bronze Medallion members, 17 Surf Rescue Certificate members and 3 Gold Medallion holders.

The constant upgrades to the training requirements require considerable time and effort for a training officer of any club and Nathan should be congratulated for his effort. In addition Nathan has been selected to sit on the South Coast Board of Lifesaving and voted in as a District Supervisor.

To assist with the training of members the committee saw fit to supply a laptop computer to assist with training. This has proved to be an invaluable tool for training, allowing us to link direct to Surf lifesaving Australia's WEB site (Surfguard) to download the latest training methods and documentation.

The club this year volunteered to be audited in its training methods by State Centre. This was a very enlightening process which will help improve the processes of training and education for the club. State Centre sent an auditor to the club where documentation and processes within the club were scrutinised, and recommendations were made as to where we could improve and comment made on what is done correctly.

The skill level and fitness of the juniors within the club is high praise for the coaches and age managers within the club and they should be congratulated.

It is also encouraging to see an increase in senior members and parents obtaining their Bronze Medallion, this helps build and bond a club.

We look forward to an increase in numbers training for the following season. We would encourage members to add to their qualifications for the season 2010/ 2011 by obtaining additional awards such as, IRB Driver, IRB Crewman, Advanced Resuscitation, Silver Medallion Patrol Captain and the Gold Medallion among others.

Beach Patrols 2009 - 2010 Season

The 2009 – 2010 South Coast Surf Life Saving beach patrolling season, covering 3/10/2009 until 25/4/2010, saw us once again achieve a fatality free year. This is a reflection of a consistently good turn out by the majority of patrol members in our club and many thanks to you all for your conscientious efforts.

Our patrols overall clocked up over 6200 hours patrolling our beach last season. This reflects an increase of 32% in our patrolling hours. The injection of new patrol members through the newly accredited Bronze groups was a big help and a big thank you to all the new members who are good enough to help with protecting the bathing public. We had a challenging season at times with generally larger seas and continually shifting sand banks causing problems with rips and troughs on our beach. This could be an ongoing trend in coming seasons and extra vigilance will be required to make sure we set patrol flags up on the safest area of the beach.

We also have major repairs and replacement costs each year due to damage and loss of the clubs patrol equipment. Please be responsible and considerate when using any of the clubs equipment (Radios, rescue boards, IRB etc) and make sure they are used, returned, and stored in the appropriate fashion to curtail these expensive repair and replacement costs.

We are still required to have a patrol on the beach from 9am-5pm from the start of the season right through to the end of next season. To cover this training is a priority to facilitate qualified people to take on positions as Patrol Captains and IRB drivers.
