## President's Report

Warilla Barrack Point Surf Lifesaving Club, has just completed our 51st<sup>th</sup> season of patrols at Warilla Beach and we are now looking forward to a short break. The 2010/11 season has been another successful one for our club with our members having provided over 5000 voluntary hours, patrolling Warilla Beach. Our aim is to provide a safe beach for the public and our members. In this area our patrolling members have excelled in their vigilance and service. We can report no fatalities at Warilla Beach.

Our thanks to Club Captain, Peter Condran, Wynn Morris our Rescue Services Co-coordinator, also to our patrol captains who obtained a high standard of participation from their respective patrols. Over 63% of our members have received 100% patrol attendance. It is also pleasing to see our membership numbers have increased in both senior and junior activities.

Again our patrol hours were the same as last season 9.00am to 5.00pm on Saturday, Sunday and Public Holidays. This obligation was met by our club members. It was announced at Branch Presentation that our Club finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in the branch patrol competition.

A patrol audit was conducted by Surf Life Saving NSW. It highlighted the fact that the procedures that were put in place by the committee were followed and that the audit took half the time of previous audits and revealed no problems.

One aspect, contributing to our achievements was the award training led by Dave Hough and Nathan Perretta with assistance from the Michael Beveridge & Hayley Mansbridge. This team put over 50 candidates who were successful in gaining their surf lifesaving awards. As we know, training officers are so important to the success of a club, and so we say, “thanks” to Dave and Nathan.

The building committee is drafting plans for the surf club renovations. As soon as these are ready they will be submitted to Shellharbour City Council.

Our club held a variety of fund raising ventures, including BBQ's at Bunning's, Surf Life Saving Appeals Day and many more. The club is planning a Golf Day at the start of next season, with more information to follow.

After the success of our 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary weekend, we now have the “Warilla Oldies” which is open to new members. The Oldies is suited to the more senior members enjoying social evenings and fundraising for the club.

Representing our club at the World Kayaking Championships, 2011 is David Smith. Also at the World Junior Championships will be Maddison Prior, Kristy Higgison and Scotty Smith, we wish them all the best for the championships and well done on making the team.

Our club played host to rounds of the Sydney Water Surf Series and the South Coast Boat Series. It was great to see so many of our club members assisting on these days. The club is appreciative of all members who assist the club in any way a member can.

In competition our club had another outstanding season. This can be attributed to our coaches and those who assisted and to the members whose dedication to training allows them to reach the high level of competition at Branch, State and Australian Championships.

We hosted 2 carnivals this season, Sydney Water and a round of the Warilla Boat series, fantastic effort by all in preparation, catering and competition.

During the Boat Carnival we hosted around 30 children of various ages from Legacy, they had a great day and really enjoyed themselves.

Donna Bagnall took on the Web Master looking after our club’s web page and after a sharp learning curve, mastered the job. Information on the web has been up-to-date and members (and visitors) have been using the site as a source of information.

Lorraine Bradwell is in her second season as club secretary and has really performed well. Lorraine has been utilising Surfguard as a communications tool by sending out e mails & SMS and ensuring correspondence is up-to-date. Note: if you are not receiving either SMS or Email I suggest you contact Lorraine and provide contact details. Having a good secretary makes it easier for other committee members to do their jobs, thanks Lorraine.

Peter & Wyn have done well with our patrols, given the extended season and issues with one or two patrols in regards to attendance in the latter half of the season. Hopefully we will have a new patrol enclosure for next season that is a bit more suited to windy/wet weather.

Presentation Night, was a very successful night and as in keeping with the past couple of years, was well attended by our members. A good meal was provided, awards presented, a DJ provided music and a good night was had by all who attended.

Congratulations to all of our members who received awards and trophies, special mention to Bev Tener (Club Person of the Year), Ben Carberry (Special Achievement), Alison Bonetig (Encouragement Award), Ali Day (Competitor of the Year) and Dave Hough (Patrol Person), not to mention Patrol 8 (Champion Patrol) all worthy winners. The nominations for these awards were hotly contested.

Competition wise we again excelled. We have won the Sydney Water Series 10 times, this is a credit to our junior and senior members (and trainers/coaches). When you think about it, when the series started a number of our senior members were in the junior ranks, it has been great to see them develop.

We had to do full patrols from October to April this year. It was a long season and given the weather and attendance records on the beach I still question the need to have full patrols for the early/end of season. At these times there were more patrol members on the beach than public!

Unfortunately this season some members (minor numbers) failed to follow the Members Code of Conduct Code. When this happens it can create situations that can impact on a number of people and can result in resentment and ill feeling. The committee needs to ensure that the Code is followed and take any action required to enforce it. If a member feels they have not been spoken to or treated in a fair manner then they are encouraged to contact one of our Member Protection Officers or approach one of the executive.

Club requirements under the Liquor Gaming & Racing legislation were highlighted at a conference at Bateman's Bay last year, when a presentation by a representative from the department provided some really interesting information about compliance under the Liquor Licencing Act and Charities Acts. The club must ensure we are following the guidelines. It was an eye opener for a number of clubs represented at the conference.

In finishing I would like to thank President, Alan, for his commitment and efforts in ensuring the best for the club, a lot of what Alan does is behind the scenes and not many members are aware of how much time is spent on surf club issues.

# Club Captain's Report

The 2010-2011 South Coast Surf Lifesaving beach-patrol season, covering 25/9/10 to 26/4/11 saw us once again achieve a fatality free year. This is a reflection of a consistently good turn out by the majority of patrol members in our club. Many thanks to you all for your conscientious efforts.

Warilla Barrack Point patrols, overall, clocked up over 6200 hours patrolling our beach last season. This reflects an increase in our patrolling hours on the beach by 32%. The injection of new patrol members through the newly accredited Bronze groups was a big help, in getting us through the increased requirements. A big thank you to all the new patrolling members, who are good enough to help protect the bathing public.

We had, once again, a challenging season, with bad weather at times and generally bigger seas and continually shifting sand banks and increasing problems with rips, and troughs on our beach. We also had many shark sightings this year and had to close the beach for periods numerous times. This could be an ongoing trend in coming seasons and extra vigilance will be required to make sure we set patrol flags up on the safest area of the beach, with elevated vigilance required.

We also have major repairs and replacement costs each year due to damage and loss of the clubs patrol equipment. Please be responsible and considerate when using any of the clubs equipment (radios, rescue boards, IRB etc) and make sure they are used, returned, and stored in the appropriate fashion to curtail these expensive repair and replacement costs.

We are still required by SLSNSW to have a patrol on the beach from 9am – 5pm from the start of the season right through to the end, next season. To cover this, training is a priority, in order to facilitate qualified people to take on positions as Patrol Captains and IRB Drivers.
